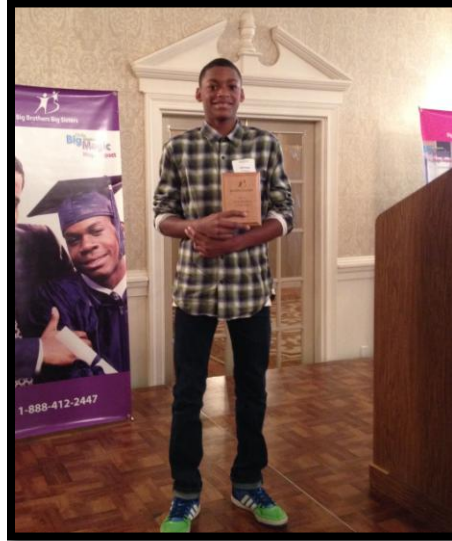


Rise and Shine Breakfast Features

This month we spotlight Director of Community Based Programs, Gloria Thompson. Gloria's responsibilities include interviewing and evaluating volunteers as possible Bigs, interviewing potential Littles and their

families and then making the actual match. After the match is made Gloria regularly follows up with both the Big, the Little, and the Little's family. Gloria supports community based matches helping handle problems, answering questions, and offering suggestions when either the Big or the Little have issues with the match. Gloria also helps out with match activities and fundraisers.

Gloria's association with the agency started back in 1993 when she began working on and off as a part time employee. In 2011 Gloria retired from the Vineland Developmental Center after working 30 years as a Social Worker and became a full time Match Support Specialist at Big Brothers Big Sisters of Cumberland & Salem Counties. Prior to working at the Development Center, Gloria worked at the Veterans home in Vineland.

Gloria keeps very busy outside of the office, working out at least three times each week. She enjoys spending time with her two children and four grandchildren. She spends time with her circle of friends, traveling, dining, and attending concerts. Gloria is active in her church and is currently working to become a certified Christian Counselor through her church.

When asked what is her favorite part of her job she said the Matching process, when the Little and Big meet for the first time. Seeing how each child reacts to their Big, some shy and reserved, some chatty and outgoing, knowing the match will make a difference in the Little's life.
